“How Donald Trump Won the GOP Nomination and Handed the Election to the Democrats”

This brief talk will discuss how the reform of the nomination process in the early 1970s and the Buckley v. Valeo 1976 Supreme Court decision made Donald Trump's nomination possible in 2016. Though the result remains to be seen, Political Science research would indicate that Trump's nomination should likely hand the presidential election and control of the Senate to the Democrats. This talk is scheduled for the day after the town hall presidential debate; thus, some time will be reserved for an analysis of the debate.
