Now, it's one of the popular destinations in the park. If we feel up to it, we could add on another 2.5 miles to see Car Wreck. Bring water, sun protection, sturdy shoes and COVID face covering.

## WALK December 16

### Dana Point Headlands & Bluff Top Trail - (9:30 am)

The Bluff Top Trail is a historical walk along the Dana Point Bluffs. This walk offers beautiful views of the Dana Point Harbor as well as some insight into the history of Dana Point. The Dana Point Headlands Trail is lined wire rope and there are plenty of benches for viewing the wildlife and sunsets. This "moderate" walk is about 3.5 miles.

*Meet at the Dana Point Nature Interpretive Center which is located on the Dana Point Headlands overlooking the harbor. Free parking. The Nature Interpretive Center is located at 34558 Scenic Dr, Dana Point, CA 92629 (Green Lantern becomes Scenic Drive).*
